Covers recent developments in constitutional law affecting federalism; the effects of budgetary constraints and cutbacks on state and local governments and lobbying groups. Also includes a study of CHA ( Chicago Housing Authority) site selection and tenant assignment policies from 1963 through June 1971 which found that CHA operated its federal programs in a racially discriminatory manner. A concluding chapter by Riccucci pulls together and synthesizes the various themes of the profiles.

This book will serve as an ideal text for courses on intergovernmental relations and federalism, and will be of interest to government practitioners and civic and nonprofit organization leaders involved in public policy and management.
